On October 21, 2016 there will be an Educational Campaign being held in School Districts and Communities and across BC

As Transportation Professionals it is our role to ensure that this is not just an efficient means of transportation but also the safest!

Operation Safe Stop BC is an ASTSBC education initiative which addresses the problem of motorists who illegally pass stopped school buses. By coordinating activities and public information efforts, Safe Stop educates the motoring public that passing a school bus with its red lights flashing is both illegal and dangerous.

A 'One Day' Project being held throughout the Province and within School Districts is a method to introduce Safe Stop to British Columbia Communities.



REMEMBER:

Yellow Lights mean the bus is going to stop. Slow down! Prepare to stop.

Red Lights mean students are getting on or off the bus. Stop!

Safe Stop is intended to focus on Driver Education & Enforcement and Keeping Our Kids Safe! With the increasing number of vehicles sharing the road with school buses, more close calls or near misses are happening EVERY day. It is important to get the word out! Safe Stop Education & Enforcement Day is an educational opportunity that could be adopted as an annual event. October 21, 2016 is the date set aside to conduct the first Provincial Safe Stop event in BC.
