Electronics/Electrical Technician

Under the supervision of the Director of Operations or designate, this position will install, test, repair, and maintain electrical equipment and systems. This position may be required to start work at various project locations.

Successful applicants will have:

- completed Grade 12;
- a B.C. or Interprovincial Journeyman Electrician Ticket with commercial/institutional maintenance experience;
- one (1) year Electronic Technician Certificate;
- two (2) years experience as an electronics technician;
- demonstrated ability to install, program, test and repair fire and intrusion alarm systems;
- a working understanding of PA systems/media retrieval;
- a valid B.C. Drivers License.

Applicants will be expected to:

- have knowledge of current construction/maintenance safety practices;
- possess the physical condition and health to carry out the required duties of this position;
- maintain good interpersonal and communication skills;
- have or be able to obtain a valid Field Safety Representative (FSR) certificate of qualification;
- have or be able to obtain certification as a Registered Fire Protection Technician with ASTTBC;
- have working with Microsoft outlook, word and excel and work order system;
- complete SD23 online safety training.

This is full time continuing position starting as soon as possible, working 40 hours per week at a wage rate of \$34.06 per hour, plus a comprehensive employee benefit package including extended health and dental coverage, short term and long term disability insurance and participation in a defined benefit pension plan.
